1. Complete this form and hand deliver, mail, fax, or email to the Williams Lake Regional District Office (Suite D, 180 North Third Avenue) between September 23, 2024 and 4:00 p.m. on October 24, 2024.
2. If your application is filled out correctly, the Cariboo Regional District will send you a mail ballot package.
3. Following receipt of the mail ballot, you are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot is received at:
 - a. The Cariboo Regional District Office in Williams Lake (Suite D, 180 N Third Avenue) or Quesnel (#102 – 410 Kinchant Street) no later than 4:00 p.m. on October 25, 2024; or
 - b. Between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on General Voting Day, Saturday, April 26, 2024, at the polling station located at École Red Bluff Lhtako Elementary (1533 Maple Drive).

The ballot you receive will ask:

Are you in favour of the Cariboo Regional District adopting Bylaw 5492, which will authorize the borrowing of up to \$3.25 million over 30 years to provide for the replacement of the Red Bluff firehall?

(The estimated annual cost to undertake this borrowing translates to a residential tax rate increase of approximately \$21.40 per \$100,000, for a total residential tax rate of \$60.68 per \$100,000 of the net taxable assessed value of land and improvements.)

To be eligible to vote in the Assent Vote you must be:

- 18 years of age or older on October 26, 2024; and
- A Canadian citizen; and
- A resident of the Quesnel Fringe Area Fire Protection Service Area OR a non-resident registered owner of real property in the service area for at least 30 days prior to voting day; and
- A resident of BC for at least 6 months prior to voting day; and
- Not disqualified by law from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.
